Born 1976 in Greeley, Colorado. Lives and works in Ann Arbor, Michigan, USA.

Biography

Monica Rickhoff Wilson is an American artist, born in 1976 in Colorado, now working and living in Michigan. She is a ceramic sculptor and is best known for her color and high temperature, custom made, micro-crystalline glaze palette. Variations in glaze chemistry and flocked fiber surfaces give this work its visual and physical tactility.

In this ceramic art collection, Rickhoff Wilson references abundance and fertility with an edge toward excess and obsession. She builds on earlier works where soft thrown hollow forms are combined and finished in one glaze. The new generation of pieces are made in multiple parts and glazed separately. Parts are glazed on all sides and suspended while being fired in the kiln. The final works are assemblies of porcelain, stoneware, and terracotta – conglomerates, that shift and move, unlike traditional sculpture.

Rickhoff Wilson earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Eastern Michigan University in 2003, where she studied ceramics and sculpture. Her training continues through travel and artist residencies. Residencies include: Penland School of Craft, Penland North Carolina; Anderson Ranch, Snowmass Village Colorado; Centro de Arte Curaumilla, Valparaíso, Chile; Maker Works, Ann Arbor Michigan; and Kripal Kumbh Pottery, Jaipur, India. Her works have been exhibited throughout Michigan, in Chicago, and up-state New York. She was given the Award of Excellence at the Original Art Fair, Ann Arbor Michigan, and was awarded Emerging Artist with the Michigan Ceramic Art Association. Her notable exhibitions are Pewabic Pottery, Detroit; Steidel Contemporary, SOFA Chicago; Muskegon Museum of Art, Muskegon; the Robertson Gallery, BBAC, Birmingham; and WSG Gallery, Ann Arbor Michigan.
